Stichting ASFF is a foundation dedicated to the organisation of cultural events, film programming, promotion, exhibition and distribution of Cinematic experiences in The Netherlands with a special focus on Spanish and Latin American Cinema.

Formally engaged with research projects exploring the legacies and potential of filmmakers and video artists around the world, ASFF curate all steps of film programmes for different institutions such as cinemas, art centres, museums and consortiums.

The main project of the foundation is the **Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival** (ASFF), a unique film exhibition in The Netherlands that allows people based in Amsterdam and broader audiences to discover and engage with a carefully honed selection of Spanish Cinema from Spain and Spanish speaking Latin America.

ASFF, launched, organised and solidly programmed by **SIN FIN CINEMA**, provides with a showcase of new trends of mainstream Spanish Cinema as well as focusing on independent, artistic and experimental Spanish films. The Foundation aims to spread Spanish and Latin American art and culture across the Netherlands and to create a meeting place for film explorations and quests with its activities.

ASFF foundation wants also to introduce Spanish films to new and young Holland-based audiences, while approaching bigger Dutch audiences and national cultural institutions across its territory, particularly in the Dutch Universities and colleagues. The objective is to promote the Spanish language and encourage new and young audience's interest in Spanish Cinema and to increase its desire to explore and learn more about it.

ASFF foundation is especially looking for new perspectives and cross connections between Spanish and Dutch filmmakers in order to promote intercultural communication and dialogue. We would like to increase Dutch and academic population's understanding and knowledge of Spanish Cinematography and enable a space for discussion and knowledge around Spanish and Dutch filmmakers. ASFF has a mission to lead and spread a wide range of filmmakers and talented Spanish Cinema with strong structure and permanent guidance.

We want to provide and set a permanent networking platform within Academic organisations and Universities sharing interest or potential interest in Spanish Cinema (film production and distribution companies, cultural and educational institutions from both countries, Spain and the Netherlands)

The **festival** is **growing**, not only with regards to the length and the number of films, but also **in brand awareness** and as a respected institution in the **Dutch cultural field**.

After the success experienced by the ASFF in the previous 3 editions, the 4th edition of ASFF was held from 29th of May to 3rd of June. This year's program included a total of 25 films within 8 different sections bringing a total of 20 Dutch premières, 4 co-productions, 17 feature-fiction films and 8 documentaries in a six-day showcase of Spanish Cinema representing the richness and variety of our cinematography.

A total of 8 films were followed by a **Q&A** with the directors, actors and screenwriters of the selected films in order to bring to the audience the chance to get more involved and dig into the creative process of these films at the hands of the creators.

Professional moderators, film festival programmers and representatives of the Dutch film scene such as Saskia Koetsier (film critic/journalist) Raúl Niño Zambrano (IDFA programmer) Maarten Dannenberg (dutch actor), Guerlinda Heywegen (Filkrant Live), Samuel Hubner (Programer CinemAsia) were in charge of these engaging dialogues with the audience which helped to provide the viewer with that extra value that our festival seeks for its audience.

Live Music performances of Almudena Rubio and Davide Cristiani performing Lorca's poems or the music of rap singer David Ransanz aka "Niñato" accompanied by Ester Blanco in a fusion with classic dance from the south of India were some of the highlights of this edition's intertwinement of film and music.

The visitor was also offered with and extensive 'Spanish' experience after most of the screenings of the festival where they could enjoy Spanish wine, tapas and jamón ibérico and have this way the opportunity to extend the dialogue with the filmmakers, international film professionals and other visitors beyond the screening rooms. A trademark of ASFF that sets us apart from other festivals in a more intimate while festive and relaxed atmosphere.

During this six-day showcase of Spanish Cinema, the 4th edition of Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival included a total of 25 films within 8 different sections:

The Core Program with a selection of the most exciting recent Spanish films from a variety of genres, a Music Documentary section, an Educational Program accompanied by didactic records for teachers and students of Spanish, a special screening in 35mm to re-discover gems of Spanish Cinema in the section Treasure from the Past. And already a tradition in our program is the section Spanish Cinema Without Fear, a very special selection of Spanish works that defy tradition and have the courage to experiment on the periphery of the Spanish cinematographic industry.

4th Edition: A total of 25 films, 3 new sections, 2 new festival venues

We were also very pleased to present 3 new sections this year: a selection of the most eccentric, surrealist and funny moments of recent Spanish Cinema in **Spain Laughs**, and with the aim of promoting intercultural communication and dialogue bringing up again a special attention to Latin American Cinema, **Focus Argentino** this year, and **Spain meets...!** with an special focus on **Japan** through an exceptional culinary experience.

First Rotterdam edition at LantarenVester

ASFF 2018 included the presence of acclaimed and honoured filmmakers such as Fernando León de Aranoa (2 times Golden Seashell winner at San Sebastián International Film Festival and 3 times Best Director at the Goya Awards), Ramón Salazar (several nominations and prizes at International Festivals including a nomination for the Golden Bear at the Berlinale and winner of Best Directorial Debut at Stockholm Film Festival); Elena Martín (Silver Biznaga at Málaga Spanish Film Festival for her first feature film). Also present were representatives of Spanish Cinema such as well known and versatile actress Carmen Machi, actor, director and screenwriter Paco León (several times awarded for his first feature film at International Festivals), actor Ernesto Alterio (Silver Biznaga at Málaga Spanish Film Festival) and the octogenarian, eccentric and extraordinary debut actress Julita Salmerón.

The number of **visitors has increased again** from the previous edition, with a total attendance of **4.344 visitors**, a very positive indicator of the growing awareness of ASFF within the Amsterdam audience.

Our media coverage has also grown demanding interviews to our team and guests also on Radio and TV. Our Social Media Channels, particularly Facebook and Instagram, have exponentially increased 59/%.

Our audience has enjoyed the variety of films in the program and the opportunities provided to be in contact and share thoughts with the filmmakers and actors during the Q&As, students have learned and enjoyed the activities specially prepared for them, and film professionals networked in the now well-known ambiance that has become intrinsically linked to our festival.

As a tradition, this 4th edition of ASFF included a special Launch Event to kick off the festival on May 1st with the première of *El Presidente*, and two exclusive opening and closing galas with the Dutch premières of *Loving Pablo* and *Perfect Strangers*, with the attendance of the acclaimed director Fernando León de Aranoa and the actor Ernesto Alterio as the main guests of the opening and closing films respectively.

With this edition ASFF presented yet another extraordinary line-up of recent Spanish films that were screened throughout the entire city of Amsterdam in the wonderful and impressive Tuschinski theater, at Eye Filmmuseum, het Ketelhuis, Pathé de Munt and at our new venue this year Cinecenter.

The festival featured films from various genres, demonstrating the compelling variety of current and classic Spanish Cinema in all its richness. From engaging thrillers to entertaining comedies, from moving dramas and exciting action movies to heartrending documentaries.

Furthermore, this year ASFF has been proud to present the first **Rotterdam Edition of the Festival**, in which new audiences manifested their wish to continue having the possibility to watch more Spanish Cinema in their city thanks to **LantarenVester**.

- Our program included 20 Dutch Premières from a total of 25 films
- 3 new sections: Spain Laughs, Focus Argentino, Spain meets: Japan! And 2 new venues
- Representatives from 19 media covered the Festival
- Media Value on printed media 47.940 €
- A total of 9.583.015 visitors/followers/likes via online coverage
- ASFF introduced to the Dutch audience 22 films from Spain and 3 from Latin America from which 17 were feature fiction films and 8 were documentaries.
- 280 students from an age range between 8 and 18 years attended the Educational Program
- The Opening Night with the acclaimed director Fernando León de Aranoa as our guest attracted 487 visitors



- 265 individual items of media coverage (including articles, reviews, interviews and mentions)
- Several collaborations with IDFA, Roze Filmdagen, CinemAsia, Pathé Gay Night FilmKrant, FilmAgenda,, ESPANJE and Instituto Cervantes.
- The Q&A after the screening of La tribu with Paco León and Carmen Machi reached 2.1k people on Facebook Live and generated a traffic of 654 comments, shares and reactions.
- ASFF 2018 hosted acclaimed guests such as Fernando León de Aranoa, Ramón Salazar, Ernesto Alterio, Paco León or Carmen Machi.


- The screening of Luna Grande, un tango por García Lorca followed by a live performance of Almudena Rubio and Davide Cristiani of some of Lorca's poems had an attendancy of 189 visitors. Their live performance was also followed by 868 people on Facebook Live and generated a traffic of 105 comments and reactions.
- All the screenings part of the Cine Expat session at our new venue Cinecenter were sold out.
- The Closing Night with the presence of actor Ernesto Alterio delighting the audience with an extended Q&A had an attendancy of 363 visitors



The marketing campaign started with the Programme Launch on May 11th, and concluded with the launch of the Rotterdam Edition on June 5th 2018.

OUTREACH

ASFF outreach initiatives included our involvement with other festivals such as IDFA, Roze Filmdagen and CinemAsia, Dutch film distributors like Dutch Filmworks, Cinemien, Nuts & Bolts and September Films, as well as with media such as RTL Boulevard, NRC, AD Algemeen Dagblad, Telegrapgh, Het Parool, GraziaFilmkrant, Espanje Magazine, Uitkrant, A-Mag and FilmAgenda.

We also carried out extensive outreach through partnerships with other cultural and social organisations such as **Instituto Cervantes** in Utrecht or **InterNations** with whom we are in constant contact in order to achieve and develop ongoing projects throughout the year.

For the first time this year, ASFF has been on **tour** to the number-one spot for the best arthouse cinema in **Rotterdam, LanterenVenster**, where the first **Rotterdam Edition** of ASFF has taken place the weekend after with 5 films from the program. This has allowed Stichting ASFF to reach a bigger audience that normally would not come to Amsterdam and realised that there is a great demand of Spanish Cinema in this bustling city in South Holland.

The marketing strategy is underpinned by a vigorous publicity campaign, generating over 265 individual items on media coverage across newspapers, magazines, radio, TV and online media— representing a € 47.940 media value and reaching 2.475.000 people only in the case of printed media.

PUBLICATIONS

Festival Program brochure & Posters

The cornerstone of the Festival's promotions is the 48-page Program brochure. 10,000 copies were printed and distributed throughout Amsterdam, in key cultural locations and a digital version was posted and distributed online.

Complementing the Program brochure there was a Launch event and a Festival poster highlighting the Festival and its supporters. 5000 copies were distributed throughout Amsterdam and its cultural café network and at key Festival Venues including Pathé and Eve Fimmuseum.

Trailer

The ASFF trailer was played repeatedly at the Festival cinemas in Amsterdam during the two months prior to the Festival, reaching 20.000 people only during the festival days. Additionally, it was shared on online magazines, blogs and social media channels.

Website

In 2017, ASFF website was updated in functionality and design, with a focus on mobile experience. Visitation grew with 28.100 unique visitors, a 27% increase from last edition

Newsletters

Our newsletter remains one of the most effective ways of driving traffic through to our website and our collaborators website through the embedded links, surpassing paid advertising. Over 42.100 emails were sent during the 2018 campaign period.

Our number of subscribers this year have raised in 400 subscribers and the overall ope rate remains at 28%, surpassing again industry benchmarks. Dedicated newsletters to Eye, Pathé, Cinecenter, Het Ketelhuis, Lanteren Venster, Instituto Cervantes and Cineville were sent prior to the Festival days.

As a society in rapid and constant change due to the new technologies and with an 80% of our audience between 25 and 55 years old wiling to create and generate opinion, we believe that the immediacy of social media is a powerful tool that we should use to spread immediate content and in an effective way. Most of this audience is social media savvy who regularly engage with friends and followers to share where they are, what they do and how they do it, and so we do.

This edition we have increased the number of followers in all of our social media channels and worth to mention is the increase in the number of people supporting ASFF via **Instagram**, which has **increased a 59%** from 2017.

We believe in the power of social media to connect with audiences, and therefore we continue tailoring content throughout the whole campaign. In our 4th edition, every post we fired off throughout the entire period, shared a #asff2018 hashtag—showcasing festival moments during the days and nights and announcing the program. We also encouraged our audience to share their moments using the same hashtag together with our sponsor's hashtag and promoting its brands.

We experienced again a strong growth across all of the Festival's Social Media Channels—through dedicated and content-driven strategies such as promotion through different competitions.





The cultural discourse in the commercial cinematic field in the Netherlands - too often dominated by hypes, American blockbusters and sequels – has a room for the various forms of Spanish and Spanish Speaking Cinema (and other alternative cinema) in the programming of the big cinemas in Amsterdam. This is despite the fact that this kind of cinema was generally received well in the past by Dutch critics and visitors alike.

Niche festivals such as Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival have the potential to attract larger audiences than through the normal distribution channels working as a bridge between cultures and reasserting and reinforcing the multiculturality of cities like Amsterdam, and most importantly, its interculturality.



ASFF has the potential to attract larger audiences than through the normal distribution channels

In this context, ASFF wanted to create once again an open space to consider the (artistic) quality of fictional storytelling, documentary storytelling, experimental cinema and classical pieces from the Spanish and Latin American context on the stage. Our goal has been to convey the history, current status and the future of Spanish Cinema by combining a multicultural audience with Spanish filmmakers and artists, and incorporating aspects of Spanish culture at each of our events.



Under this structure, we wanted to host an intercultural exchange and further development since we believe it is important in today's society to make the unknown familiar. Also, to celebrate different cultures and bring them together. Cinema is a powerful tool that brings people together in a unique way through their common love and interest in seeing their own culture and those of others.

Amsterdam is characterised by the vast amount of different cultures present, therefore it seemed to us the ideal environment in which to reach our objectives. By bringing once again these beliefs and ideas together, we approached Amsterdam audience with the celebration of the fourth edition of ASFF and the first Rotterdam Edition of the festival the following weekend



The 4th edition of the Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival program consisted of several activities in which Spanish Cinema, film art and culture came first.

The films were selected on the basis of a number of criteria and characteristics. The ASFF - in partnership with Dutch, Spanish and Latin-American distributors - used the following guidelines:



It is especially important for Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival to be able to collaborate with this venue, and especially to host this section, for what this institution represents in the Film Heritage field and its strong position in the academic field. Therefore, it was an honour for festival director Virginia Pablos to introduce to the Dutch Audience a film that represents not only one of the most important works from the filmography of the Catalan director, but also from Spanish Cinema and which was awarded with several national and international prizes. Among those stand out the Best Film and Best Director Goya Award in 1991 and the Silver Bear for Victoria Abril at the Berlinale same year.









After six days full of the most exciting, funny and representative examples of contemporary Spanish and Latin American Cinema, ASFF feels honoured to have been able to host its already fourth edition of the festival in Amsterdam. Ernesto Alterio explained during the Q&A that followed the film how he built and played one of the most edgy characters of this ensemble movie that shows how frightening truth can be when you have something to hide.

Hoofdprogramma

Het festival toort een zergvuidig gesleichseret programme van recents Soaanse films in verschillende gegenes, die de johanniek en crestlijkeit van de hedendaagse Spaanse inceine reflecteren. Spain Laugh

Een nieuw programmaonderdeel met de meest excentrieke en sumedistinche momenten uit de Speanee cinema is Spain Laughs. In Muchas hijos, un mono y un castillo (Lots of Kids, a Moniezy, and a Castio) door de pasgetrouwde Julita dre wersen: veel kinderen, sen aap en een kazede. Nadet al haar wensen zijn uitgekomen, ontdekt dere bijzondere dame de werkelijke betekenis van het leven... Na droop van de voroosziling is er en QAA met hoofdrisskeesistez hijutta Salmeréen.

Dot de avente komedie Perfectats desconacións (Perfect Strangers) van Alars de la Iglesia is te den in Spein Laughs. Tijders cen etentje steck iremand uit de virendengroep voor om een speil te speient leg je teletion oo tatel en lees harbop de inkomende berichten voor. Dat lijst orischuldig, todast je lets te verbergen hebt... Perfects desconacións is tevens sjortlin van het festival. Na de voorstelling zin leden van de cast aanwezig voor een QBA en s er een feestelijke borrel.

Focus Argentino

In dit onderdoel zie je een glimp van al het moois dat de Argentijnse cinema te bieden hoeft. De Argentijnse filmmaker Constanza Novicii laat mer El future que viene (The Future Ahead) de levenslange, maar ingewilkkeide vriendschap zelen tussen twee vrouwen op drie crudale momenten in hun leven: eerste liefde, eerste kind en eerste scheiding.

Spanish Cinema Without Fear

Een speciale selectie van Spaense films die tradities op de schop nemen en de moed hebben om te experimenteren en de grenzen op te zoeken. Eén van de geseiecteerde film is Nifeto. Deze film goat ower David, een jonge, werkloze vader die met zijn zoontje bij zijn ouders woont. Naast zijn dagelijfese bezigheden probeer hij ef en toe even tijd te vinden voor zichteff en zijn passie voor ritme en muziek.



Na afloop is **hoofdroispeler en rapper David Ransanz, ook wel bekend als Niñato, aanwezig.** Naast een Q&A zal hij het publiek live kennis laten maken met zijn muziek.

tucic Documentary

Indestructible, el alma de la salsa (Indestructible, the Soul of Salsa) is een prachtige muzikale documentaire die de kijker meencemt op reis naar de oorsprong van salsa. De Spaanse famenco zenoer Diego "El Cipala" wordt gevolgd tijders zijn reis on een salsa-elbum te maken.

In Spain Meets: Japant laat het AFSS samen met Cinemasia Soul zien. Soul verkent de geheimen van de gestronomie, woor twee keukens (die blijktoar to tegengesteid zijn in hun filosofie, denikheid en ervaring) de hoogste culinaire erkenning hebben gekrepen, nameliik fell Michelin-sterren.

Treasure from the Past

In dit programmoonderdeel worden bijna-vergeten pareis getoond uit de Speanse Cinema. Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival (29 May until 3 June) announces programme and opens tickets sales

The full programme of the Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival has been announced, Ticket sales have also started via the websites of the participating Amsterdam chemas. Here are a few of the programme components.





Core programme

The festival screens a carefully selected programme of Spanish films from different genres that reflect the dynamic, and creative aspect of modern Spanish cinema. One of the films from the core programme is Le enfermedated del domingo (Surday's Iliness), in which an upper-class women unexpectedly gets a visit from her desulpter whom she ebendoned thirty years ago, Her daulotter makes a strange request to spend the right stoother.

The screenings will be followed by a OSA with director Ramon Salazar.

Also part of the core programme are: opening film Escabar (Fernando León de Aranca), El Aviso (Daniel Calparson), No Sé Decir Adós (Lino Escalera), Lina Grande, Un Tango Por Gardo Lorca (Juan José Ponce) and El Autor (Manuel Martin Cuenca).

Spain Laughs

Spain Laughs is a new section of the programme that features the most excentric and surrealists moments from Spanish chema. In Muchos hips, un monor y un castillo (Los of Kids, a Monkey and a Castle), newlyword Julia makes three withers lots of Kids, a monkey and a castle. After all of her wishes have been granted, this special ledy discovers the true meaning of life.

The screening will be followed by a Q&A with protagonist Julita Salmerón.

In addition, the black comedy Perfectors descondation (Perfect Strangers) from director Álex de la Iglesta can be viewed in Spain Laughs. During a dinner amongst a group of friends, one person suggests they play a genne; put, your phone on the table and read the incoming messages out loud. This seems innocent, until you have something to hide. Perfectors descondations is also the closing file.

Cast members will be present for a Q&A after the screening and a festive gathering will celebrate the end of yet another successful edition of the festival.

Focus Argentin

This section will give the audience a glimpse of all the fine things Argentinean cinema has to offer. With El future que viene (The Future Ahead), Argentinean Filmmeker Costanza Novick illustrates the lifelong but complicated friendship between two women at three crucial moments in their lives: first love, first child and first directe.



Spanish Cinema Without Fear

A special selection of Spanish films will dramatically reshape traditions and have the courage to experiment and push the bounderies. One the selected films is NiFato. This film is about David, a young, unemployed father who lives at his parents' house with his son. When he is not busy with his daily activities, he tries to find some time for himself and his passion for rhyme and manner.

Protagonist and rapper David Ransanz, also known as Niñato, will be present after the screening.

Besides hosting a O&A, he will give a live introduction to his music.

Music Documentary

Indestructible, el alma de la saisa (Indestructible, the Soul of Saisa) is a spiendid musical documentary that takes the audience on a journey to the origins of saisa. The documentary follows Diego, "El Cicale" on his journey to make a saisa record.

In Spain Meets: Japani the ASFF screens Soul, in collaboration with Cinemasia. Soul explores the secrets of gastronomy where two cuisines apparently so opposite in their philosophy, conception and experience, have both earned the highest cultural recognition: three Michelin stars.

Treasure from the Past

In this section of the programme, [nearly] foogleten gens of Spanish cinema are screenct. This year, the audience has the opportunity to see Annantes (Lovers), based on the real story of a young man who, having just been dismissed from military sentors, books for a job to earn money and many this gliffiend. While he is looking forwar, he takes lodging in the house of a wisdow, with whom he starts an affair until his flancde finds out about them and tries to win

Amantes is screened in a 35 mm format in EYE.

Venues

The Ameterdam Spanish Film Restwal tables place from 29 May until 3 June in the Duton capital. This year's venues are Pathfi Tuschnicia, Pathfi de Munt, Het Ketelhuis and Cinccenter. After Amsterdam, the festival will continue its journey to Lantareniverster in Rotterdam, where Spanish onema will also be celebrated. Rotterdam will host the festival guring the weekend of 8,9, and 10 June.

After the screening of the majority of the films, one has the opportunity to discuss and reflect while enjoying a bite and a drink.

Iberico ham and other Spanish delicacies will ensure that the audience has a real Spanish (film)experience.

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THE STUDENT HOTEL

In terms of audience, once again the number of visitors raised and the percentage of younger people from the age range 18-24 also increased. Furthermore, we are consolidating a younger audience of students through the already well-known Educational Program amongst schools and educational institutions of the region and who expressed their intention to participate in future editions even demanding some other possible activities alike during the academic year. ASFF has become a unique film exhibition initiative allowing people based in Amsterdam to discover and engage with the Spanish film industry and culture. This year a new audience has been introduced to our network when taking the festival on tour to Rotterdam. The direct contact with these visitors after the screenings showed us the increasing demand of Spanish Cinema in different spots of The Netherlands. These visitors not only have praised the initiative but also have been interested in being connected with us for further projects that could bring more Spanish and Latin American Cinema than only the one brought through the normal distribution channels. One of our goals for next editions it is precisely to consolidate Rotterdam as a new Hub in The Netherlands for Spanish Cinema.

We recognise the ongoing need to continue growing and maturing. This means developing increasingly stronger ties with filmmakers, content producers and industry professionals; not only in Amsterdam but globally, while maintaining strong relationships with government agencies, industry associations and corporate partners. Having been granted for the first time with Prins Bernhard Cultuurfonds, and the increasing support of NL Film Funds, Amsterdam Fonds voor the Kunst and Acción Cultural Española in Spain, we are even more certain and excited about our place in the field. It also validates once again our believes and our goals. We will continue monitoring the projects and initiatives already created and in progress. We will also be looking at ways to expand and improve further the ASFF's reputation and programming. For further editions we would like to put more attention and collaboration on a higher educational and academic level with lecturers, professors and other film professionals taking direct part in the events presented to the audience. There are different aspects such as heritage and film aesthetics that we would like to address in a more academic way with the different institutions and universities in the Netherlands and enhance this way the professional network of the festival and enable that space for discussion and knowledge with Dutch filmmakers and professionals.

The ASFF - launched and solidly curated by SIN FIN CINEMA - provided unique events and an insight into the most innovative film dialogues that are currently developing inside non-standard and narrative audiovisual formats. The ASFF programme exhibited the current trends and focus of mainstream Spanish Cinema, and simultaneously shone a spotlight on independent and art house Spanish and Latin American films.
