We are proud to announce a program primarily made up of **Dutch premieres**, which also highlights the **talent** of **female directors**. Most of the selected films are directed by women, supporting female Spanish talent.

To guarantee an unforgettable experience, we invited some of the directors and actresses that will join us in person to share their work. We are very pleased to host one of the best Spanish actresses nowadays, **Candela Peña**, who will present our opening film: *La Boda de Rosa / Rosa's Wedding*, directed by Icíar Bollaín. Also the internationally recognized **Belén Cuesta**, lead actress in two of our selected films. Some of you might recognise her from *La Casa de Papel / Money Heist*, and at the festival you will discover her work in *La Trinchera Infinita / The Endless Trench* and in the phenomenal *Sentimental / The People Upstairs*. She will join the audience for Q&A after both films! In this year's edition you will discover the inspiring true story of *Maixabel*, with stand-out performances by Luis Tosar (*Retribution, Way Down*) and Blanca Portillo (*Volver*), who will join us for a Q&A!

Keeping up with our commitment to the LGBTIQ+ community: we present the must-watch mini-series *Maricón Perdido / Queer You Are* directed by Bob Pop and inspired by his own life. Both the director and actress Candela Peña will be attending for an exclusive Q&A after the marathon screening. A unique experience not to be missed! Another film to celebrate the heritage, culture and contributions of LGBTIQ+ groups with a humorous point of view is *Donde Caben Dos*.

The young director Júlia de Paz will be attending the festival for the international premiere of her second film and solo debut *Ama*, a portrait of the myth of maternity which was screened at the San Sebastián International Film Festival this year. Emilio Belmonte's music documentary *Impulso* takes us deep into the early creative process of dancer and choreographer **Rocío Molina**, who will be attending for a Q&A with the audience after the screening.

We are also proud to continue presenting **Spanish Cinema Without Fear** in our programme with two outstanding documentaries. *Destello Bravio/Mighty Flash* provides a discussion on how people continue to propagate patriarchal traditions in an evolving world. *El Año del Descubrimiento/The Year of the Discovery* will take the audience on a deep dive into post-dictatorship Spain with the epically proportioned and wonderfully absorbing documentary.

Once again, we will also showcase our beloved Focus Latino, this time featuring México, compadre! We are proud to premiere the dystopian film *Nuevo Orden*/ *New Order* directed by Michel Franco, along with some mexican nibbles to spice up our Mexican reunion.

A Glimpse into Cinema from Andalusia; in partnership with Turespaña and Andalucía Tourism Board; Andalusian cultural identity will be portrayed through cinema with the screening of three exceptional films: *El Verano que Vivimos; Antonio Machado, Los Días Azules* and *La Trinchera Infinita* along with a Q&A with special guest Belén Cuesta. Director Laura Hojman will reflect on her critically acclaimed film about Antonio Machado, one of our most celebrated figures of the Spanish literary movement known as the *Generation of '98*.

Highlighting the festival's DNA, and synergy between the Spanish and Dutch cultures, **Spain Meets The Netherlands** will showcase *Las Consecuencias / The Consequences*, the perfect combination in a Spanish-Dutch co-production, with Claudia Pinto behind the camera and renowned Juana Acosta as leading actress. The wild Canary Islands landscape creates a unique and hypnotic atmosphere that delves into the deepest depths of human nature.

And last but not least, since we may all need a bit of comedy to wrap up 2O21 and to spend some screentime with super star Javier Bardém, we will be closing this year's edition with *El Buen Patrón / The Good Boss*, an upand-coming Spanish comedy film directed by Fernando León de Aranoa, recently presented at San Sebastián International Film Festival.

Tasty ham and Spanish drinks will follow most of the screenings to offer our lovely audience a true Spanish Cinema experience!

A woman watches time passing next to the suitcases of her exlover (who is supposed to come pick them up, but never arrives) and a restless dog who doesn't understand that his master has abandoned him. Two living beings facing abandonment.

In 30 mesmerizing minutes, Swinton's nameless character runs through a frightening gamut of emotions, from despair to fury to exhilaration, all while isolated in a luxurious apartment that's also a stage set; her only companions are her ex-partner's dog, Dash, and the betrayer's unheard presence on the other end of her phone. Almodóvar used many of his frequent collaborators, including cinematographer José Luis Alcaine and composer Alberto Iglesias, for this impeccably designed yet combustible adaptation of Jean Cocteau's 1930 play The Human Voice.

A short, sharp shot of distilled Almodóvar: passion, emotion, heartbreak, wit, and melodrama exquisitely bound up in a tale for our times. *La Voz Humana / The Human Voice* was shot over nine days in Madrid in July and recently premiered to critical acclaim at the Venice Film Festival.

*Maixabel*, the inspiring true story of a woman who, after having violently lost what was most precious to her, decided to take a brave step towards coexistence and peace by agreeing to face the imprisoned ETA terrorist behind the murder of her husband. A film ripe with emotion and humanity, with stand-out performances by Blanca Portillo (*Volver*) and Luis Tosar (*Retribution, Mondays in the Sun, Way Down*).

In the year 2000, Maixabel Lasa's husband, Juan María Jaúregui, was killed by ETA. Eleven years later, she receives an incredible request: one of the men who killed Juan wants to meet with her in the Nanclares de la Oca prison in Álava (Spain), where he is serving his sentence after breaking ties with the terrorist group.

Despite her reservations and her immense pain, Maixabel Lasa agrees to meet face to face with those who ended the life of the person who had been her companion since she was 16 years old. 'Everyone deserves a second chance', she said, when asked why she was willing to confront the man who killed her husband.

She travels the world to perform her partly improvised impulsos at unusual venues such as modern art museums. This bio-doc follows Molina in the months leading up to a new show at Chaillot National Theater in Paris.

Rehearsals and performances alternate with interviews with family members, friends, colleagues and accompanying musicians. Her mother explains how as a small and somewhat stocky girl wearing a pink ballet outfit, Molina found herself in Madrid surrounded by stylish flamenco dancers dressed in the more traditional black costumes. But from there she rapidly rose to the peak of her profession.

Cita is not satisfied with this; her hopes are fixed on something different. She leaves her husband and roams the small town.

This highly original drama often looks like a documentary, but also takes inspiration from surrealism and magic realism. Using non-professional actors, a very special, disruptive electronic soundtrack and suggestive camerawork, *Destello Bravío/Mighty Flash* proves that even the everyday can be exceptional.

By utilizing such a specific environment, "Destello" tackles universal issues such as the need for transcendence through fables or faith – be it faith in heaven or in magic, patriarchal legacy, or the need for tradition as a rock to cling onto in these convulsive and changing times. Considering the loss of identity that marks our globalized world, I do believe that beyond the basic layer of attractive local Spanish exoticism, the international spectator will find something relatable in the story.
