This year's festival expands to six venues. In Amsterdam: LAB111, Pathé Tuschinski, and Eye Filmmuseum remain our main cinemas, with a new location introduced. Het Documentaire Paviljoen at Vondelpark, showcasing our Women on Docs in collaboration with IDFA. Additionally, screenings will debut at FilmKoepel Haarlem and Cinema Amstelveen for the first time

We are proud to announce a program primarily made of Dutch premieres, composed of some extraordinary films that have had an amazing run at international festivals and treat a scale of different themes and social issues. We have an exciting lineup laid out for you full of international guests, special events, Spanish music and gastronomy.

To commemorate a decade of culture exchange between Spain and the Netherlands, ASFF is delighted to be honored with a royal visit from two very special guests: Their Majesties QUEEN LETIZIA OF SPAIN and QUEEN MÁXIMA OF THE NETHERLANDS, gracing our festival to commemorate its decade-long journey. They will attend a Celebratory Colloquium and will also meet with the students participating in our Educational Program. Their presence underscores the deep commitment of the Spanish and Dutch Crown to promoting Spanish culture in the Netherlands, as well as their support for initiatives fostering collaboration and intercultural dialogue.

In keeping with our commitment to introducing some of the greatest talent of the current Spanish film industry, we are delighted to bring directors and cast to Amsterdam to personally share their work with you.

The festival will commence with two premieres on the Opening Night, both from our section: Where Love Goes, dedicated to celebrating the heritage, culture, and invaluable contributions of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and intersex individuals in Spanish society. Actor JAIME LORENTE, known for his outstanding performances in *La Casa de Papel* (Money Heist) will attend the International Premiere and Pre-opening film of *Disco, Ibiza, Locomía*.

Additionally, original Locomía band member GARD PASSCHIER will attend the premiere in his home country. Gard and Jaime will lead a Q&A session after the film, discussing the wild days on the island and the contrast between fiction and reality in Ibiza during the 80s.

The Opening Night film *Te Estoy Amando Locamente* (Love & Revolution), a cheekily combative comedy about a dedicated Sevillian mother who, after her son's coming-out, decides to fight for LGBTQIA+ rights in the 70s, when homosexuality was still a crime in Spain. Alejandro Marín breaks through with this entertaining heartfelt comedy that tears traditional taboos aside and defends the right to love. Director ALEJANDRO MARÍN and artist LA DANI will attend the Premiere!

Opening night ready to set the tone for what promises to be an unforgettable festival experience!

Spanish Cinema Without Fear section, will give the chance to the audience to meet the renowned actor OMAR AYUSO and director and multidisciplinar artist JULIA DE CASTRO, presenting her new film, *On The Go*, which was awarded at multiple International Film Festivals.

Another name that stands out from our guest list is the internationally acclaimed director JAVIER FESSER who will present his latest film: *Campeonex* to the festival audience with a special participation in our Educational Program.



10 years of Spanish Cinema in the Netherlands

INTERVIEW WITH RENÉ WOLF

Film distributor, former Head of acquisitions & programmer at Eye Filmmuseum

1. One of your first encounters with ASFF founder Virginia was at the Eye Filmmuseum, when she introduced "The Spanish Film of the Month" concept to you. What are your memories of your first meeting?

I remember how Virginia very enthusiastically advocated that Spanish cinema was so much more than Pedro Almodóvar and that she wanted more people in Amsterdam to notice the wide variety of films made in Spain. I also remember that I was afraid that she wanted to host a festival in Eye and we were already overwhelmed by the number of festivals in our venue.

Therefore I loved (and still love) the concept of 'The Spanish Film of the Month', being a monthly-event with a Spanish fil screened at the location that suits the title best: a commercial film in Pathé, an arthouse-film in Rialto, an artfilm in Stedelijk Museum etc., etc.

2. And then this quickly developed into the Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival? Where you onboard with this idea immediately?

No, I think the concept of 'The Spanish Film of the Month' was a brillant one and I was very much in favour to continue it that way. But of course I understand the difficulties of organizing a monthly event in different venues against organizing a festival in terms of financing, workload, organization etc. Still, there are many festivals, but the concept of The Spanish Fllm of the Month was unique and therefore still very dear to me. I also think it's a problem of the strict guidelines of grant providers: to apply for subsidies you have to qualify as a festival. But I think they should reward the idea, the purpose and the goals behind it, not so much the form.

3. As the former programmer at Eye Filmmuseum, you played a significant role in shaping the festival's programming. How did you perceive the role of Spanish cinema in the Netherlands during your tenure, and how has it evolved over the years?

Actually, I would argue it's not more than a very modest role. Of course, by attending many festivals abroad. I was aware that Spanish cinema was so much more than Almodóvar and we did already occasionally screened other Spanish films in Eye. But it was a fact that a lot of great Spanish films didn't make it to distribution in the Netherlands nor played at other festivals in our territory. I sometimes suggested titles to Virginia that in my opinion were worthwhile to be seen on the big screen and somemade it to the



festival's programming, especially in the Spanish Cinema Without Fear section or a restored classic. I think there is much more awareness now how vivid, diverse and good the Spanish(-speaking) film production was and is and we see also more Spanish films in regular distribution now, but that credit should go to Virginia and her team.

4. From your perspective, what does the Dutch film industry think of the ASFF?

I think the industry values it a lot and some distributors wait with a Spanish(-speaking) title to launch it during or near the festival. But for me the films that you can only see during the festival are the most important element.

5. The 10th edition of the Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival is a milestone. Looking back, what are some of the most memorable moments or highlights from previous editions that stand out to you?

There are many. Films like the restored classic *El munde sigue* (1963), *El año del descubrimiento* (2021) and *Destello Bravío* (2021), guests like Julio Medem, Alex de la Iglesia and Víctor Erice and of course the Spanish wine and jamón as well...

6. The ASFF has managed to bring the most well-known Spanish filmmakers and cast from Spain. Do you have a favourite Spanish director?

When it comes to film history of course Luis Buñuel, Carlos Saura and Victor Erice, from directors of nowadays I'm a big fan of Jonás Trueba: *La virgen de agosto* (2019), *Quién lo impide* (2021), *Tenéis que venir a verla* (2022): very different but all very worthwhile.

7. Spanish cinema is known for its diversity and rich storytelling. How do you think the festival has contributed to promoting and celebrating this diversity within the Dutch cultural landscape?

The nice thing is that Spanish cinema is as diverse as its country is. I appreciate that there are many regional funds in Spain that enable and encourage films to be made outside the big cities. The festival reflects that diversity and as such shows and introduced films from and stories from very different areas to a Dutch audience.

8. Could you elaborate on your personal involvement with the festival? What motivated you to support and contribute to the Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival?

For me as a programmer but also as a spectator The Spanish Film of the Month and ASFF enabled me to watch Spanish films on the big screen that I would otherwise have missed or was forced to see on my pc or television screen.

9. As the festival marks its 10th edition, what trends or changes have you observed in the reception and appreciation of Spanish cinema in the Netherlands, and how has the festival adapted to these shifts?

I do think a much larger part of the audience knows now that Spanish cinema means much more than Almodóvar, I really think more Spanish films make it to regular distribution now and so the festival can even more go after the hidden pearls.

10. Looking ahead, what are your hopes for the future of the Amsterdam Spanish Film Festival, and how do you envision its continued role in promoting Spanish cinema and cultural exchange in the Netherlands?

I know the festival always has to struggle to find enough space in cinemas during the dates of the festival. Therefore I also hope that it can do more activities year round. If not a Spanish Film of the Month, maybe a Spanish Film of the Quarter would be possible? And I truly hope that funds would accept that as applicable festival form as well.







OMAR AYUSO

Internationally renowned actor who gained fame through his role in the successful Netflix series Élite.






JOOP GARD PASSCHIER (GARD)

Illa de Arousa, 1971. Maria is a woman who earns a living harvesting shellfish. She is also known on the island for assisting women in childbirth with special dedication and care. The director Jaione Camborda made history with this film and became the first Spaniard female director to win the Golden Shell at San Sebastián Film Festival 2023.


CAMPEONEX




ROBOT DREAMS

DISCO, IBIZA, LOCOMÍA

The film delves into the rise of the Spanish music band Locomía during Ibiza's 1980s club culture boom, tracing their journey from aspiring fashion designers to global music sensations. Discovered by music industry magnate José Luís Gil, despite lacking vocal talent, they skyrocketed to fame with their groundbreaking style. Their fans were obsessed with them and they made millions. But all this success came at a high cost: their own freedom.






